About The City of Qiryat Bialik

Qiryat Bialik is a city in the Haifa District of Israel.

Founded on **18.07.1934** as a neighborhood close to Haifa, the neighborhood was established by the immigrants of the fifth aliyah from Germany and its first name was "Neighborhood of German Immigrants."

A group among the immigrants who aspired to engage in agriculture founded a nearby village.

When the poet Haim Nachman Bialik passed away, it was decided to name the two nearby settlements, Qiryat Bialik and Kfar Bialik, after him.

In 1950 Qiryat Bialik was recognized as a local council, and $\underline{in\ 1976}\ as\ a\ city.$ The number of inhabitants today

Inclusive Programs:

- **Special Needs:** A variety of classes and activities are offered for people with special needs, ranging from ages 5 to 20+.
- Lesure Club for Retirees: A wide variety of classes are available for retirees (Third Age).
- Special Interest Groups:
 - **Ofarim Community Center:** This unique club caters to former USSR veterans and operates in the mornings. It offers various classes and serves as a leisure center for retirees.
 - **Dan Community Center:** This leisure center for retirees operates in the mornings and offers a variety of classes.
- Volunteer Opportunities: The Qiryat Bialik Community Center offers volunteer opportunities for retirees to give back to the community.
 - **Zahav in Kindergarten:** Retired volunteers teach children in kindergartens about road safety.
 - Intergenerational Classes: Retired volunteers conduct classes specifically for other retirees.
- **Coffee on Tuesdays:** This program at the Tzur Shalom Community Center features lectures in Russian, specifically designed for expatriates from the USSR.

Additional Services:

• Two Day Care Centers: (Parpar) and (Tevim) - These centers accept children from 3 months to 3 years old.

Enriching Classes:

- Theater, Science, Culture, Art, Languages: The center offers a wide range of classes in various fields, catering to diverse interests and age groups.
- **Gymnastics:** The community center fosters a strong gymnastics program, including folk sports, acrobatics, apparatus gymnastics, and artistic gymnastics. Talented participants even represent the city in competitions.

Unique Clubs:

• **Men's Club "Just Us Men":** This unique club at the Harkafot Community Center provides a dedicated space for men, offering a variety of workshops and activities tailored to their interests.

Special Projects:

- **Bar/Bat Mitzvah Celebrations:** The center organizes special Bar/Bat Mitzvah ceremonies for children from the Ethiopian community, immersing them in the customs and traditions of this coming-of-age milestone.
- "Keys" Project: This subsidized program provides affordable classes for children from the Ethiopian community, ensuring equal access to educational and enrichment opportunities.
